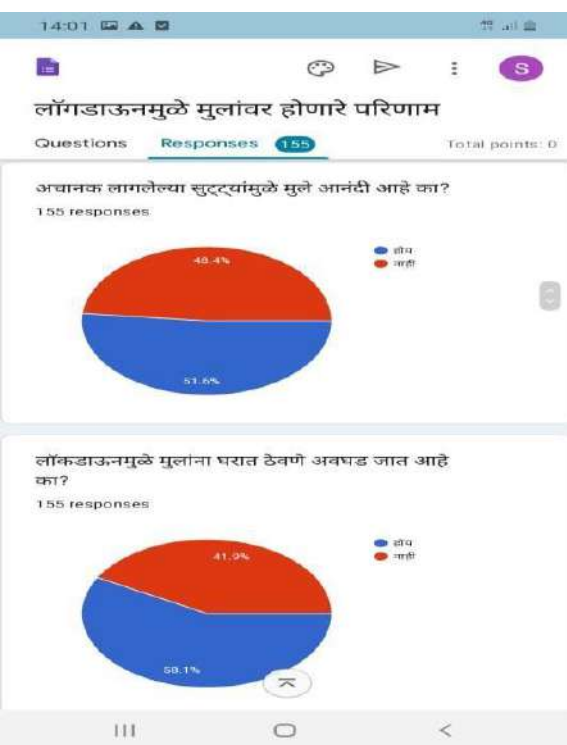
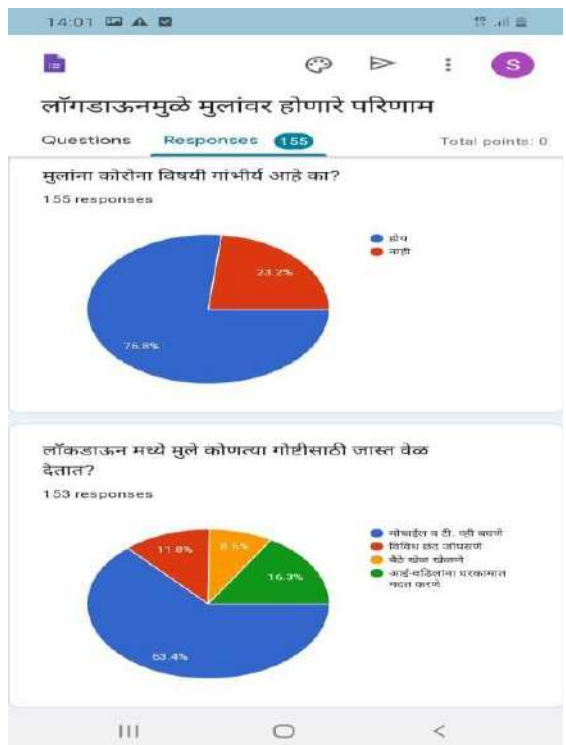
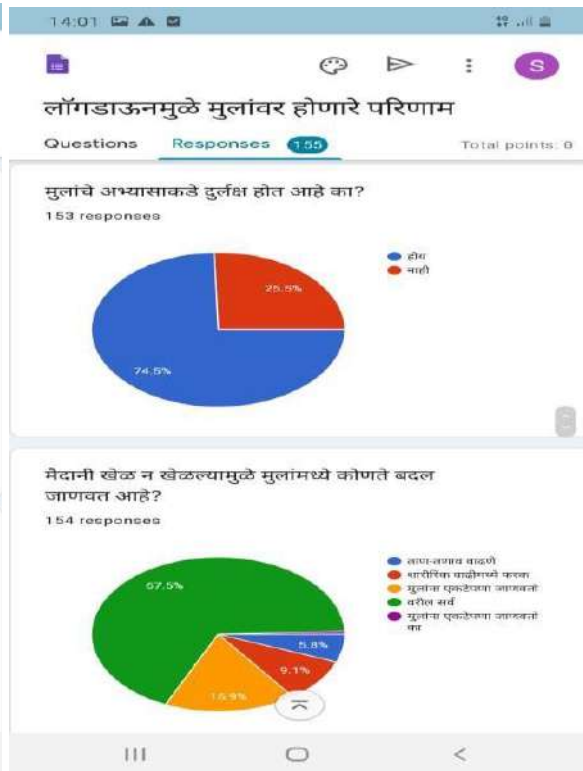
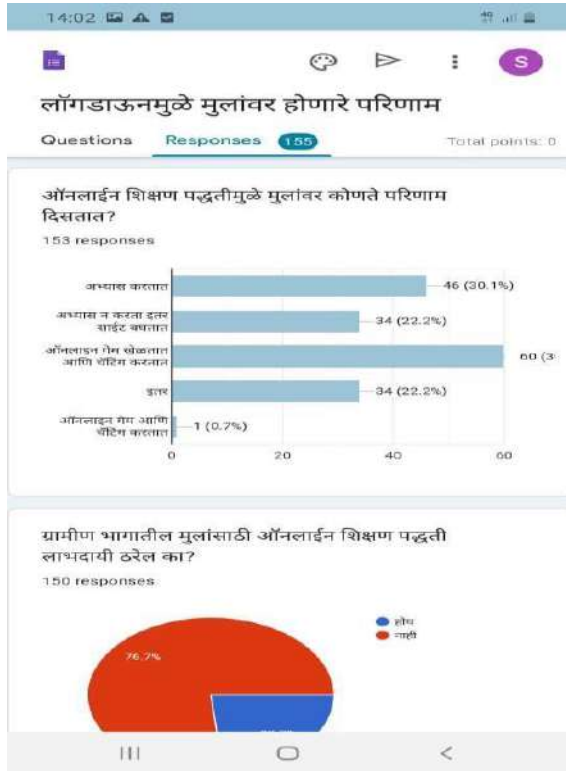


Soft skill Development Program Dated 04-07 Feb. 2020

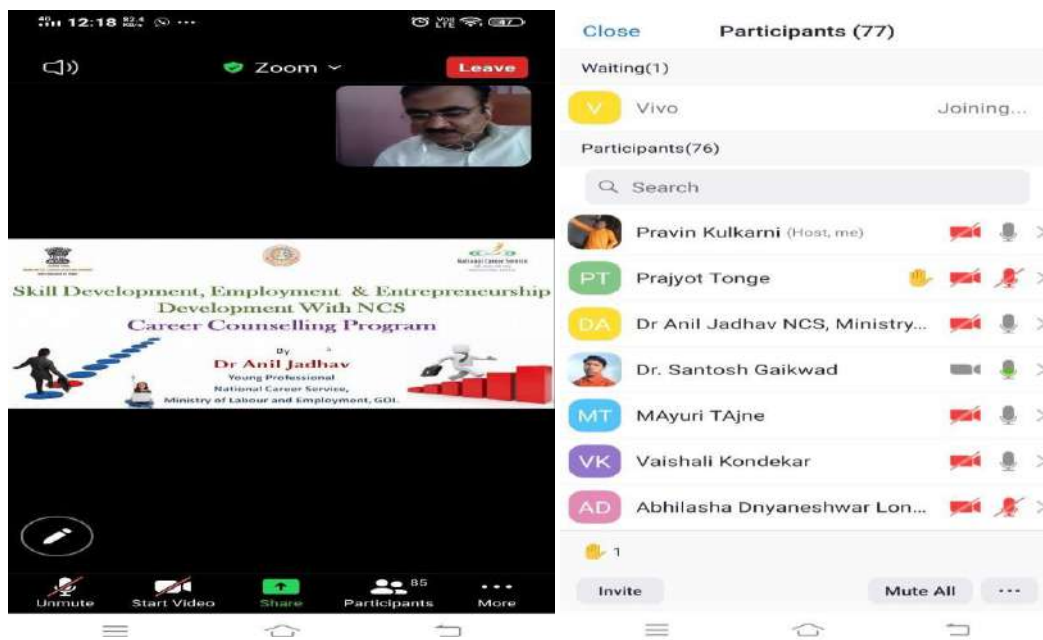

## **Report on 'Online Photography Competition' on Wildlife week'**

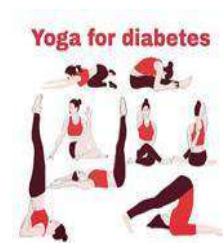
